



Approximate Fallow Deer Gestation Table-230 days

Fallow deer (*Dama dama*) are a unique member of the cervidae family that range in color from white (born tan), “black” (which is a two toned cocoa colored), “menil” (spots on light brownish coat) and “common” which is rusty colored with white spots. Males typically weigh from 175 to 200 lbs in good condition but lose some weight during the rut and on average weight about 153 lbs during that time. Females weigh from 55 to 100 lbs, averaging around 82 lbs. Breeding season is typically from September to November or later in some areas, but peak breeding is in October. One buck can generally service up to 35 females. A fallow buck is characterized by its Adam’s apple which slides up and down its throat as it “barks” at females when in rut. Both male and female tend to reach maturity around 14 to 16 months. Does can cycle for 3 to 6 months (if not bred), at intervals of 21 to 25 days for 12-24 hours.
